A Crew volunteer day is a great way for you and your group to experience TWS and help the cats we care for. Most tasks consist of heavy farm chores, so volunteers should be able to work hard in all kinds of weather.

Crew volunteer days help build habitats, hammocks and perches.

- Groups must consist of 6 more people that are over the age of 18
- Hours of volunteering are 10 – 4 p.m. A full day must be given.
- Please bring your own lunch and beverages
- Expect to work outside and it to be physical work
- Volunteer day includes orientation, history of TWS and a tour of the sanctuary to review rules, regulations and safety protocol for your day of volunteering
- No contact between the public and animals is permitted
- A liability release must be signed by all volunteers

The Wildcat Sanctuary (TWS) is a 501(c) 3 non-profit, no-kill rescue facility, located in Sandstone, Minnesota. TWS provides for the humane rescue and sheltering of unwanted, mistreated, and neglected privately owned wildcats that pose a risk to public safety. We do not buy, breed, trade or sell animals. TWS is committed to public education about the captive wildlife crisis; offering veterinarian training opportunities; and supporting legislative solutions to the public safety issues created by private ownership of wild animals.

The Sanctuary is accredited by the American Sanctuary Association. The Wildcat Sanctuary has garnered endorsements from the Minnesota Zoo and the University of Minnesota’s Veterinary Care Program.
