


UPROAR! February 2018

A PAW-SOME Year For The Cats!







hen I reflect on the year behind us, I continue to be overwhelmed and amazed by what is accomplished with a humble budget and small group of people – including YOU!

Our animals are the luckiest in the world! We never stop making improvements for the animals we've rescued, and at the same time continue to open our hearts to those in need.

Join us in celebrating the success you made possible for the cats in 2017, for so many rescued wild cats and one dog.

Habitats and Residents

- 6 tigers, 2 bobcats, 4 hybrids and one rescue dog were welcomed at the Sanctuary.
- Habitats were renovated for tigers Jeremy &
 Simon, Zeus and Sabrina including new trees,
 hammocks, and multi-tiered platforms. Jeremy and
 Simon received a new cave made from boulders.
- Lioness Shanti Deva received a renovated cave, a new platform and perch system and a new jumbo-sized hammock for her indoor room.
- The '4 Wild' cougars Aspen, Blaze, Snow and Storm received a HUGE new roofed habitat complete with several platforms, trees, cave, den boxes and four indoor, temperature-controlled rooms.
- The '5 Wild' cougars Noah, Carlo, Andre, Donoma and Langley's **indoor rooms were renovated**.
- The three bobcats, Tractor, Athena and Libby, moved into their new free-roaming habitat in the Feline Meadows section of the sanctuary with access to a temperature-controlled room.
- **Skywalk systems** were installed for bobcats Henry, Haley, leopards Shadow and Shazam, and hybrids Maximillion, Leo, Diego, Ella and Indie. This provides them all much **more vertical use of their habitats.**



- Hybrid Haven was reconfigured and new habitats completed to accommodate cats that want to live alone. A new large bungalow was constructed with three yards for Leo, Abby and Maximillion. This freed up another bungalow for Savannah cat Kona.
- Bobcats Belvedere, Francis and Autumn graduated to a larger habitat in Wildcat Pines.
 This freed up a bungalow and yard for Bengal cat Adrian.
- Lynx Lindsey received a new cave for shade, one of her most favorite places to lounge.
- Cougars Raja and Liberty received a refurbished cave made of boulders to replicate their old concrete cave for ease of use for Liberty.
- Two new heated bungalow buildings were provided for bobcats Scooter and Baby Jenga in Wildcat Pines. The buildings will be repurposed for other cats once the Wildcat Pines Renovation is complete in 2018.

New Construction

- Plans for renovation of the Wildcat Pines were completed, materials were purchased. The new design includes roofed habitats for 23 bobcats and one lynx with more vertical space. They'll all have access to a permanent, indoor temperaturecontrolled animal building.
- Excavation was started for a new lion area. This
 multi-acre area will be able to accommodate two

prides of lions and include a building allowing cohabitation and lounging for a pride, outdoor covered areas within the habitat and acres to explore. It's our biggest habitat area yet!

Hospital and Vet Care

- Hospital upgrades continued including purchasing a new digital x-ray machine, CBC blood machine and adding a Hospital Manager position.
- Indoor quarantine enclosures were upgraded to allow for more vertical space to accommodate larger cats. We installed permanent walls to aid in sanitation and drainage.
- Life-saving diagnostics and surgery were performed on leopard Shadow, tigers Daisy and Pandora, and rescue dog Cookie and needed dental work on bobcat Luna.

Equipment

- Two new utility vehicles were purchased to aid in daily feeding of animals and construction. In addition, a new rescue van was purchased for reliability on cross-country rescues.
- An automatic generator and additional tiger transport crates were purchased as part of our safety protocol. A new septic tank system was installed for the entire sanctuary.




Working for the Cats

- A **new intern house** was purchased to accommodate up to 8 interns at a time. **Growing the program** benefits the animals at the sanctuary and helps us inspire future animal advocates.
- Zone responsibilities were implemented to provide more customized care to residents.
 This supports our new strategic anchors that help guide our work.
- Sanctuary Alliance and was the host sanctuary for the Big Cat Sanctuary conference where over 40 leaders from the industry came together to share ideas and best practices. Director Tammy Thies sat on the Big Cat Rescue and Big Cat Events committee and presented Crisis Communications Protocol at the Big Cat Sanctuary Conference.
- Tammy Thies, our Director testified and was expert witness in multiple cases to ensure wild cats did not end up in private hands and that licenses would not be re-issued to repeat offenders or those with ongoing violations.
- The Wildcat Sanctuary reached 2.9 million people through Facebook. Fans have become advocates and support legislation, write letters and help educate about the captive wildlife crisis.
- On-site volunteer support was provided by over 30 Volunteer Crew Days, 6 weeks of full-time AmeriCorps volunteers and gardens were beautified by TWS volunteers.




o, what do we want to accomplish together in 2018? Take a look. You can make these miracles happen!

Construction for the cats is our biggest focus for next year.

- Over 23 bobcats need to be moved to other areas
 of the sanctuary to allow for demolition and
 construction of the new Wildcat Pines area of the
 sanctuary for 23 bobcats and one lynx.
 - Expansion of perimeter fence to accommodate the new area
 - Removing all old habitats, platforms and dens

- Excavation of the area
- Construction of the new temperaturecontrolled central animal building
- Rebuild roofed habitats that are larger and taller
- Install vertical cat walk systems, giving them double the space to explore
- Install platform systems, caves and other areas to explore
- Our largest initiative is the build out of the new multi-acre lion habitats and co-habitational central animal building. This is a large investment and will need YOUR support, as well as that of others, to make this happen. We are currently trying to help lions in need and bring them to the Sanctuary.



Hospital & Vet Care

- The hospital will receive a mini-renovation for more efficiency until the **Animal Care Center** can be designed and constructed in the coming years. A new x-ray stand, animal scale and other equipment will be purchased to complete the onsite hospital.
- Cataract surgery will give Cookie her sight back.
- Wellness exams and spays will take place on current and new residents.

Equipment

- An SUV or truck is needed for daily supply and food runs and cross-country rescues. The vehicle will need to pull our rescue trailers. New mowers are also needed to maintain the habitats and grounds.
- Ongoing maintenance is always necessary; including new siding on the current intern bunkhouse, concrete ramps for animal buildings to move transport crates, tiger pool repairs, etc.



Working Together

- The sanctuary will grow its internship program to support animal care and educate future animal advocates.
- The sanctuary will recruit and engage specialized volunteers to help with graphic design, video, building design, veterinary assistance and small hybrid cat care. Volunteers will also be utilized for events, gardens and onsite construction.
- Contribute to the Big Cat Sanctuary Alliance.
 Director, Tammy Thies will continue to serve
 on the events, advocacy and rescue committees.
 TWS will continue to support the passage of the
 Big Cat Public Safety Act.
- The Wildcat Sanctary will continue to mentor smaller sanctuaries in operations, construction and fundraising.

Building for our Future

- Plan and design of **Animal Care Center** to be constructed over the next 5 years. This will expand our hospital for better use of space and safe viewing areas that can be used for veterinary training. This building will also host our animal care staff, overnight staff, volunteer area, and provide more education and training opportunities. Moving the hospital to this new building will allow us to expand our food preparation and animal supply storage.
- Begin planning Hybrid Haven renovation.

 Many of the hybrid habitat areas were damaged
 by a snow storm in 2013. Temporary fixes were
 made for safety, but several habitats need to be
 torn down and rebuilt for long-term sustainability.

Cookie, an honorary cat

Cookie, the rescue dog has quickly become one of our most popular residents.

Found as a starving stray, she was so emaciated. The first step was letting her gain weight back slowly and carefully. Since she had diabetes and out-of-control glucose levels, we had to manage that safely, too.

Then, she had surgery to remove her mammary tumors and was spayed. After recuperating from that, she was finally ready for this last step. Could we save her eyesight?

Dr. Larocca was able to remove the cataracts in both eyes and replace them with artificial replacement lens. What would her reaction be?

YES, she can definitely see!!

Being rescued was one thing. But being able to see again – that's truly been life changing for her!


She spends so much time looking out the window, watching all the activity outside. In the past, caretakers would take Cookie for a walk. Now, she takes them!

All while we continue with the daily management of her diabetes. Caring for Cookie is time consuming, but so worth it with every wag of her tail, she gives us thanks.

She's one of a kind, that's for sure, and we thank you so much for all the love, good wishes, and support you've given to get her to this amazing point in her life!







Daisy, a tiger with a new lease on life

As you recall, Daisy arrived with a neurological disorder, causing hind-end ataxia (the loss of full control of bodily movements) and pain. After several tests, she was diagnosed with spinal meningitis (inflammation of the spine).

Then, Daisy had a setback. When we noticed she wasn't bearing weight on her rear foot, we immediately arranged for her to be seen by an orthopedic specialist. Radiographs and surgery revealed an old heel fracture that had calcified, surrounded by thick scar tissue.

Thankfully, the surgeon was able to pin and plate this fracture to stabilize her foot.

We had to keep her quiet for several months so she could heal properly. If you've seen how playful and rambunctious she can be when she's feeling well, you know we had our work cut out for us!

We know you're as anxious as we are to see her pain-free and carefree, like the Daisy we've come to love so much.

Recently, Daisy received full access back into her habitat and boy, did she have fun! Thank you for your continued support, both emotional and financial, for this very special tiger.





Spartacus, a cat that follows his own path

This little boy arrived years ago as a 12-week-old Bengal kitten with a walking disability. Due to a genetic spine deformity on his vertebrae, his back legs do not work properly. He can prop himself up on both legs, but cannot walk on them. He hops around the enclosure or he pulls his back feet.

But Sparti is one of the strongest cats in Hybrid Haven – emotionally and physically. He gets around very well in his non-traditional way and is the boss in his bungalow.

Nothing can stop this little guy and he has YOU to thank for it!
